Ethics of Online Therapy

Online Therapy is an effective medium for helping individuals, adolescents and families who would not otherwise seek and receive therapy. This workshop will open with a demonstration of Online Therapy using a working Online Therapy website. This will allow attendees to see how legal/ethical issues, theories and marketing around Online Therapy can be applied to their present practice or even open the door to a new practice. Through lecture, demonstrations and case presentations, attendees will learn Online Therapy skills to legally and ethically better serve the growing population of people using the Internet. This certification workshop will offer information, tools, resources, and best practices for using Online Therapy with individuals, adolescents, children and their families. The session will discuss ethical and legal issues associated with using the Internet. Discussion will compare similarities and differences between online and traditional therapy. Attendees will learn how Online Therapy may be used as the primary therapy medium or as an adjunct to traditional therapy. Case presentations will highlight technology strategies for prevention and intervention. Lecture and discussion will highlight some of the most effective clinical approaches, theories and interventions when using Online Therapy. Attendees will learn the ethical guidelines and standards for operating, managing and using Online Therapy Websites. Attendees will learn interventions suggested from theorists and practicing clinicians successfully adapting these interventions to Online Therapy. Participants will learn to use chat and video to help individuals who would not otherwise receive help. Attendees will be encouraged to ask questions and discuss specific applications and future implications for preparing family therapists to manage their practices using the Internet. Final discussion includes current legal and ethical challenges represented by state boards and implications for preparing family therapists for future technology advances.
